Annali MEMOTEF, a multidisciplinary journal reflecting the interdisciplinary nature and advanced scientific research context of the Department, welcomes cutting – edge research articles for its next volume 2019 particularly related to the following research disciplines:

- Economic and Human Geography
- Demography, Social Research, Population and Policy Analysis
- Economic Statistics
- Methods and models for research in the fields of Historical Economics and Economic History
- Linguistic analysis of specialized texts (academic, institutional, professional), interdisciplinary discourse studies, socio-cultural aspects in language use, comparative genre analysis, specialized translation
- Probability and Statistical Theory
- Mathematical and Computational Models for Economics, Finance and Insurance
- Mathematics for Actuarial Sciences

Submission process: please send your manuscript to annalimemotef@uniroma1.it; roberta.gemmiti@uniroma1.it. For the

preparation of your submission please follow the instructions for the Authors ([Preparing your Submission](#)).

The manuscript should include a short abstract (maximum 200 words) with the objectives of the study, methodology, expected results, and three to six key words. The papers should not exceed 7000 words and can be submitted in Italian, English, French, Spanish or German. If the Author (s) is not writing in her/his mother-tongue language, they are strongly advised to have the submitted work carefully checked by a native speaker.

Once your article has received an initial editorial check, the paper will then move into the peer review phase.

This process is anonymous. Each article is assigned to two reviewers with the relevant research expertise and/or editorial experience. After the review, you will receive the reviewers' feedback and publication recommendations, and any necessary revisions must be made before final acceptance or rejection. Accepted papers need to be formatted according to the [Editorial Guidelines](#).

Annali MEMOTEF also includes a section for Discussions Notes (not more than 2000 words and no review phase), as well as a Book and Conference Review section.

The papers will be published free of charge online first and collected in a volume at the end of the year (only for the manuscripts submitted before July 31).
